Tell Me a Story	
Starting Point	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Telling a story with a musical accompaniment
Possible Throughlines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Music can be used to express meaning
Challenges	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Choosing a text that is familiar • Choosing a form that is repetitious and suitable for musical arrangement
What If?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We acted out the story using movement • We chose instruments to represent characters or events or places or atmosphere • There was a song we could use to enhance the story • We presented this to an audience • Each class chose a separate story • We retold the story using artwork • We dressed up in costumes • We had an interactive display highlighting the instruments used • We recorded the work using a video or still camera
